

Withdraw From or Drop Courses

This job aid provides students with instructions on how to remove courses from their schedule. This is completed in one of two ways, depending upon when the removal occurs: Course Drop or Course Withdrawal. These actions have important implications for a student's academic record, so carefully note the differences between these actions.

Course Drop: A course drop permits a student to remove a course from their schedule *prior to the drop period end date*. This option does not count as an attempt and is not reflected on the transcript. This option is available prior to the semester's start and through the drop period only.

Course Withdrawal: A withdrawal enables a student to discontinue their enrollment in a course *after* the drop period has ended but *before* the withdrawal period expires. Withdrawing from a course is considered an attempt and results in a W grade on the student transcript. **IMPORTANT:** Students should meet with their Academic Advisor and Financial Aid Office (if using Financial Aid) to discuss the implications of this prior to completing this action, as it can negatively impact successful academic progress and Financial Aid awards.

DROP COURSE BEFORE DROP PERIOD ENDS


Follow the steps below to remove a registered course prior to the drop period end date.

From the Home page:

1. Click  MENU then select  Academics Hub .
2. From the Academics Hub Navigation pane on the left, select


Planning and Registration.

3. Select **Current Classes**. The student's currently enrolled classes for current and upcoming semesters display.
4. Scroll to the right of the selected semester to view the course options and select **Drop**.

5. Select the checkbox next to **Confirm**.




Drop Student Course Registration page with Confirm button callout

COURSE WITHDRAWAL


Follow the steps below if you are removing a course from your enrollment **after** the drop period ends.



Note: When withdrawing from multiple courses, each course must be withdrawn individually using this process.

From the Home page:


1. Click **MENU** then select **Academics Hub**.

3. Select **Current Classes**. The student's currently enrolled classes for current and upcoming semesters display.

4. Scroll to the right of the course(s) and select **Withdraw** next to the course to withdraw from. The *Withdraw Student Course Registration* page displays.
